This Service is based around a meditation Katrina wrote, inspired by being by the river Thames. It explores how rivers are central to our understanding of God at work in the world and how rivers are a good place for meditation and prayer.

### HYMN: BY THE RIVERS OF BABYLON

The Israelite leaders remember their exile in Babylon. Their captors wanted them to sing and they replied 'How can we sing the songs of the Lord while in a foreign land?'. These words are very poignant while we are in a situation where we cannot sing 'the Lord's Song' in our churches at the moment. We too long for a time when we can once again sing how great our God is. When you read the Psalm, try to read it as a psalm of hopefulness, that there will be a time when we will once again be able to join in singing to our God.

#### **READING**

Try reading this psalm as a meditation. Read it through three times. The first time straight through. The second time, pause at the end of each verse and let the words soak in and the third time read it out loud as if it is a psalm for you today.

## **PSALM 137 (NRSVA)**

By the rivers of Babylon we sat and wept when we remembered Zion.
There on the poplars we hung our harps, for there our captors asked us for songs, our tormentors demanded songs of joy; they said, "Sing us one of the songs of Zion!"

How can we sing the songs of the Lord while in a foreign land?

If I forget you, Jerusalem, may my right hand forget its skill.

May my tongue cling to the roof of my mouth if I do not remember you, if I do not consider Jerusalem my highest joy.

# THE BAPTISM OF JESUS MATTHEW 3:13-17 (NRSVA)

Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John. But John tried to deter him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?"

Jesus replied, "Let it be so now; it is proper for us to do this to fulfil all righteousness." Then John consented.

16 As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. 17 And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."
